In this position you will plan and conduct investigations on individuals and businesses involving non-compliance and/or frauds relating to evasion of tax under all statutes administered by the Ministry of Finance and under the Criminal Code of Canada. Report on investigation findings and establish evidence supporting offences to prosecute individual or corporate violators and to optimize tax revenue to the province.
