"Stingray Technology"

The practice of day-to-day policing in Canada allows for the use of Stingray surveillance technology. Stingray is the generic name for an electronic surveillance tool that simulates a cell phone tower in order to force mobile phones and other devices to connect to it instead of to a legitimate cell tower. Other common names for the tool are "cell-site simulator" and "IMSI catcher. Cell site simulators are pieces of hardware that mimic the telecommunications towers used by phones to relay messages and to send and receive calls. By tricking phones into thinking they are cell phone towers, the simulators can ... *more at acfi.ca*
